1	Project Intentions: Write a paragraph stating what you feel that you have done	
	successfully so far and how you choose to develop this further within your project. Refer	
	to examples of artists work (minimum of 6 examples) to inform and structure your	
	choices.	
2	Take 35 photos per week, relating to your work. Save these, and print them off as	
	contacts. Print the most relevant / best as wallet sized images and annotate them.	
3	10 examples of appropriate artists research as your work develops – this must be on	
	going.	
4	2 drawings per week in a variety of media and scales. Where possible include:	
	Tonal pencil, coloured pencil, watercolour paint, biro, fine liner, collage, soft pastel, oil	
	pastel, acrylic paint, sgraffito, print, chalk and charcoal and so forth.	
5	12 samples / details inspired / taken from observational drawing using a variety of media.	
6	Further artists research to inspire the development of your ideas – 6 minimum	
7	Design ideas x 8, clearly developed from initial observational drawings, details & samples	
8	Maquettes, samples, practise pieces and final design (A4 size) with annotation	
9	Final piece.	
10	Evaluation including photographs showing the progress of your final piece. This must also	
	show evidence of connections to artists work through images and your own writing.
