### **VALE OF GLAMORGAN SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS 2021/2022**

I am writing to advise on the outcome of the recent consultation exercise on proposed admission arrangements for the academic year 2021/2022. The proposed change include a minor amendment to the primary oversubscription criteria and a review of secondary school catchment areas.

The Council carefully considered all comments received at its Cabinet meeting on the 23 March 2020 and approved the proposals to include a minor change to the oversubscription criteria for community primary schools to ensure that those living in a school catchment area will be a high priority for admission to school and a revision to secondary school catchment area in order to align secondary school catchment areas to better match the capacity at secondary schools.

The school admission policy for 2021/2022 and catchment area review can be viewed on line at [www.valeofglamorgan.gov.uk/admissionconsultation202122](http://www.valeofglamorgan.gov.uk/admissionconsultation202122) Stanwell School and St Richard Gwyn Catholic School are not affected by the proposed change as they are their own admissions authority and determine their arrangements separately.
