## Mutations!

There is one more thing you need to remember when using the past tense in Welsh. After you use a past tense phrase, for example 'Bwytais i', the word that follows it sometimes mutates. This means that the first letter of the word changes. After a positive past tense phrase, there is a <u>soft mutation</u>.

## Y Negyddol

When saying that we didn't do something in the past, we need to follow the following steps.

**Step 1** - get the positive phrase e.e. Bwytais i.

Step 2 - Add ddim e.g. Bwytais i ddim.

**Step 3** - Mutate the first letter of the verb. If the Negative Past Tense starts with one of the following 9 letters the first letter will change or **MUTATE**.

The letters are:

t	Ь	m
С	d	rh
p	9	II

The first 3 letters mutate using the 'Treiglad Llaes':

t	$\Rightarrow$	th		
С	$\Rightarrow$	ch	Treiglad Llaes (T.Ll.)	
p	$\Rightarrow$	ph	(aspirate mutation)	

The other 6 letters mutate using the 'Treiglad Meddal':



## Some examples:

I sang	Canais i	⇒ I didn't sing	<u>Ch</u> anais i ddim
I	Prynais i	⇒ I didn't buy	<u>Ph</u> rynais i ddim
