What is "Identity"?

- Identity is a term to describe the unique individual characteristics of a person.
- It may be a reflection of our culture combined with inner experience and outer circumstances

Identity is shaped by many different factors. When trying to work out what makes "you" unique, you might want to consider the following areas which can all contribute to your identity:

Nationality - where you were born & where you live, family, friendships, age, gender, culture, race, religion, likes, dislikes, strengths, weaknesses, appearance, memories, beliefs, choices made, how you see yourself, how others see you, social identity, possessions, food, clothes, habits, hobbies, interests, behaviour, experiences, language, holidays, school, favourite subjects.
