### **GCSE Results 2020**

The email will be sent between 8 and 9 am on **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August**. Results will be sent to each student's **individual school Hwb account**, which students have been using to access Google classroom.

In addition to emailing you we will also be posting your results to your son / daughter via traditional methods. However, it is unlikely that they will get to you on the Thursday in question.

### **Barry Sixth Form Registration**

Students would normally register for Barry Sixth Form during the August GCSE results day. Social distancing will not allow for that procedure this year.

Students are invited to school to complete the registration process and select their A-Level subjects on **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August**. To maintain social distancing, the school asks that students adhere to the following schedule:

Surname begins **E – H**, arrive at school **10:00am**  
Surname begins **I – L**, arrive at school **11:00am**  
Surname begins **M – P**, arrive at school **12:00am**  
Surname begins **Q – T**, arrive at school **1:00pm**  
Surname begins **U – Z**, arrive at school **2:00pm**
