Dear Parents and Guardians,

I would like to take this opportunity to update you with our plans for the forthcoming weeks for Year 11, 12 and 13 pupils.

To this end we are planning in the next few weeks to give our pupils the best opportunity to develop and produce evidence of their achievements in learning. This is now possible after recent publication of further WJEC information on Centre Determined Grades.

The following timeline has been planned and includes confirmed dates from the WJEC.

W/c 7th June	Yr. 11, Yr.12 and Yr.13 pupils are required to attend lessons for named subjects. Pupils and parents will be contacted directly.
W/c 14th June and 21st June	Yr. 11, Yr. 12 and Yr. 13 pupils do not attend lessons unless a department requires the pupil to complete adapted assessments. Parents and pupils will be informed directly regarding this.
Wednesday 23rd June - Pupils to receive their Provisional WJEC Grades	Pupils to attend school for a short period of time to meet with their Form Tutor and collect their WJEC grades. Further details will be sent on this. Please note, these are Provisional WJEC Grades as the exam board will produce confirmed grades later in the summer, see dates below.
From 28th June to 16th July Bespoke Sixth Form Transition Weeks for current yr 11 and yr 12 pupils.	Current Year 11 and Year 12 pupils who are continuing into Sixth Form are asked to attend a Sixth Form Transition programme. This programme is aimed to support our students with the next step in their learning. Pupils will be required to attend for a timetable of events and wear school uniform.
16th July	Last day of term for all pupils
AS and A level Results Day	10 th August
GCSE Results Day	12 th August
