





## Tracking the positives




We always track all pupils' positive behaviour to ensure everyone reaches their potential.








#### The Importance of High Attendance


If you fall below 90% attendance your child is considered a persistent absentee.

It is a <u>legal requirement</u> for all parents to send their children to school on a consistent basis.

The school will contact and support all parents whose child falls behind in their attendance, but it is the parents' responsibility to make sure attendance is maintained.




#### Attendance – figures in context





# How you support the school and your child





- We ask the you give the form classes 6 weeks before we make any changes
